

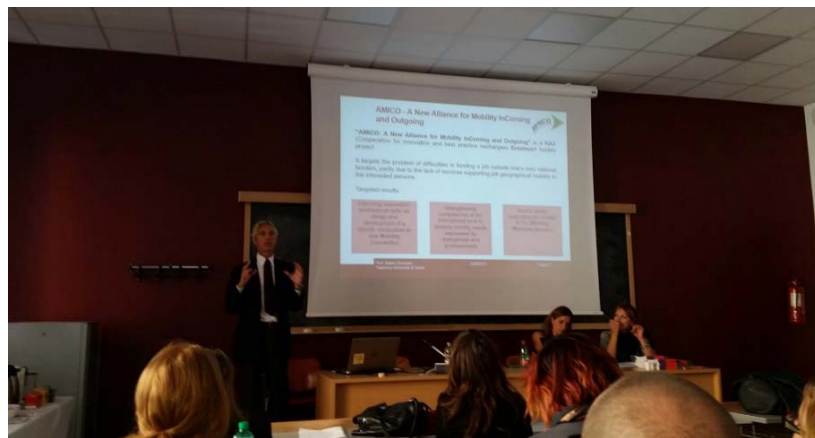

ROME, two main multiplier events in 2017

The first one took place on 22nd of September 2017 at Sapienza Università di Roma within a larger event regarding EC projects organised by the own Sapienza within SSH: "Opportunità di finanziamento nell'ambito delle Scienze umane, sociali ed economiche". During the session the project was introduced by Marino Bonaiuto, supported by Silvia Cataldi and Giovanna D'Alessandro. After that there was some Q&A and discussion time, and also during the informal time after the official session, exchanges and interactions continued with interested stakeholders. The number of participants was approximately 75 people and the general feedback from the participants was good.

The second one took place at Sapienza Università di Roma within a larger event promoted and organized by the Faculty of Medicine and Psychology at Sapienza Università di Roma entitled "Apprendere nei contesti di lavoro – Teorie e pratiche – Alternanza scuola - lavoro e dintorni" which took place on the Wednesday the 13th of December 2017. The part regarding AMICO took place at the opening session of the afternoon. The number of participants was well above the one expected and the general feedback from the participants was good. This multiplier event was useful to strengthen broader synergy and collaboration of AMICO's Italian members, namely Sapienza Università di Roma and ERIFO, with the Ordine degli Psicologi della Regione Lazio and other institutional stakeholders.

Two types of multiplier events are planned in AMICO project. The first ones were organised at the interim stage of the project and the second will be held at the end of it.

These first events were focused on the promotion of Job Mobility Counsellor Curriculum and the Toolkit for the Validation and Quality Assurance of the Curriculum.

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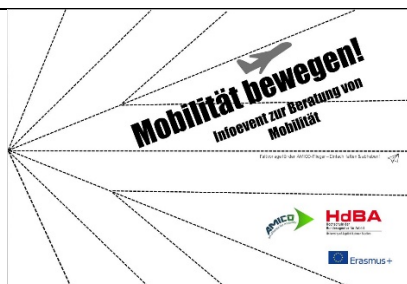
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SEVILLE, the Intercultural Mediator for Labour Mobility

Faculty of Labour Sciences of the University of Seville hosted a dissemination event to present the results of the project AMICO on October 30th, 2017. This event was attended by 50 people from representatives of University of Seville and other universities, training specialists, technician and higher education providers as well as entities related to intra-European labour mobility, labour relations, employability, education, communication, anthropology and specialists in multiculturalism who were invited to an intense morning with three main objectives:

- To disseminate the AMICO project: objectives, partnership and results.
- To present the activities of the pilot training course (on-line) of Intercultural Mediator for Labour Mobility and the curriculum for Job Mobility Counsellor that aims to fill the gap in training in the field of intra-European orientation of labour mobility.
- To show the training material to the different stakeholders.



GERMANY. Moving Mobility! Information event on mobility within the EU

On Thursday, September 28, the first Multiplier Event of the Erasmus+ project AMICO took place. AMICO aims to support professional mobility within European countries and the filling of vacant positions with qualified specialists. The project focuses in particular on the information and communication technology sector, the results can be transferred to other sectors.

The aim of the Multiplier Event was to inform about the project activities, especially the developed training of their background. Before the event started, it was already possible to visit a poster exhibition and talk to the two speakers. You could also take part in a competition. The actual program started with two lectures. It all started with Lena Holder, the responsible project employee of the AMICO project. In her presentation, she reported on future trends in mobility within the EU, future challenges and AMICO's contribution to promoting mobility. This was followed by a lecture by Robert Komaromi, who reported on his work at the Central International Placement Office in Bonn. He also addressed the challenges involved in advising people who want to work abroad or in Germany. Using illustrative examples, he illustrated which financial, emotional and motivational aspects must be taken into account in such a consultation. After both lectures there was a round of questions and an exchange on the topics presented over coffee and a small buffet.

UK, Collage Arts

Collage Arts held a multiplier event on 31st October 2017 with employers, freelancers, and entrepreneurs from the creative and digital sectors in attendance. The event was an opportunity for Collage to share information about AMICO's aims and objectives and the pilot project activities. Pilot participants were on hand to share their experience and answer questions from the audience. Collage Arts and Rinova gave presentations with plenty of time allocated for questions and 1-1 discussions with attendees. Those in attendance were particularly interested in how to run successful mobility projects in their organisations and Rinova were able to share their mobility experience and the experience of other partners they have worked with; they spoke about the challenges and key factors for success. There was time at the end for networking among attendees and staff of Collage Arts and Rinova.
